Optičeskie anomalii v kristallach. By A. G. Štukenberg and Ju. O. Punin. (In Russian.) Pp. 263. St Petersburg: Izdanya Nauka, 2004. Price (hardback) USD 26.95.

The book deals with optical anomalies in crystals. Potential readers are mineralogists, petrologists, crystallographers, and materials scientists dealing with the assessment of crystal perfection.
